Scholarship Essay Outline

The essay will need to include the following criteria:

- 1) Career Goals
 - a. What Career are you interested in?
 - b. Why?
- 2) How will you achieve your Career Goal?
 - a. What facility/facilities are you interested in?
 - b. What funding sources will be available to you?
 - c. What kind of support system do you have?
- 3) Do you have any possible career obstacles? (financial, transportation, etc.)
- 4) How will your cost of education compare to the salary in your Career field?
- 5) What employment opportunities are available to you in your Career Field?
 - a. Will you have to relocate?
